Purpose

Pensacola Christian College scholarships are available to qualified residence hall students with financial need. These scholarships are made available by A Beka® Foundation, Inc.

General Scholarship Applicant Qualifications

All scholarship applicants must meet these qualifications:

- Must be a residence hall first-time freshman who is a United States citizen.
- Must sign the Statement of Intent and declare a four-year major.
- Must submit the scholarship application *before* arrival on campus.
- Scholarship applications for the fall semester must be post-marked by August 1 (spring semester by December 15).

Scholarships

\$4,000 Ministerial Scholarship

- Available to qualified, residence hall, bona fide ministerial student who is a first-time freshman. This is determined on the basis that the student has enrolled as a Bible major including concentrations in pastoral ministries, youth ministries, missions, and music ministries; intends to be a minister of the gospel; and is from an approved Bible-believing church. Must have a “C” average or above in high school.
- \$1,000 applied to the student’s tuition at the end of the second, fourth, sixth, and eighth semesters of consecutive attendance at PCC.

\$3,200 Academic Honors Scholarship

- Available to first-time freshmen who qualify in one of the following ways: (a) graduate as valedictorian or salutatorian of a class of six or more students, (b) score a minimum composite score of 25 on the ACT, or (c) score a minimum total of 1140 on the critical reading and math portions of the SAT.

If the applicant is the valedictorian or salutatorian, a letter from the school administrator attesting to this fact must be sent.

If the applicant’s qualification is based on his ACT or SAT score, he must have an official copy of his score sent directly to the College. This is done automatically if you specify our college ACT number 0707 or our SAT number 5970 when you take these tests.

- Recipients must be full time students and maintain a 3.20 GPA each year.
- \$800 applied to the student’s tuition at the end of the second, fourth, sixth, and eighth semesters of consecutive attendance at PCC.

\$1,500 Teacher Education Scholarship

- Available to qualified first-time freshmen who are majoring in education.
- \$500 applied to the student’s tuition at the end of the fourth, sixth, and eighth semesters of consecutive attendance at PCC.

\$1,500 Music Scholarship

- Available to qualified first-time freshmen majoring in music or music education.
- Written recommendation required from the student’s high school music teacher or private music instructor. It must be sent directly to the College by the teacher.
- Must have a “C” average or above in high school.
- \$500 applied to the student’s tuition at the end of the fourth, sixth, and eighth semesters of consecutive attendance at PCC.

\$1,500 Art Scholarship

- Available to qualified first-time freshmen majoring in commercial art or graphic design.
- \$500 applied to the student’s tuition at the end of the fourth, sixth, and eighth semesters of consecutive attendance at PCC.

\$1,000 Alumni Scholarship

- Available to qualified first-time freshmen whose parent graduated from PCC in a four-year undergraduate program.
- \$1,000 applied to the student’s tuition at the end of the second semester of consecutive attendance at PCC.

Other Scholarship Information

- **Scholarships will be granted on the basis of student’s qualifications and financial need.**
- Students must be in good standing and earn at least a 2.00 grade point average each year (not cumulative) at Pensacola Christian College in order to receive the benefits of the scholarship. Students who forfeit the scholarship because of grade point average will forfeit the benefit for future years.
- Students who qualify may receive only one scholarship; they may also apply for work assistance for additional financial aid.
- Students participating in A Beka funded scholarships may not apply for the One Year Free at PCC program.
- Students must have completed the year as full-time residence hall students to receive the scholarship benefits for that year and future years.
- A Beka® Foundation reserves the right to make changes in these scholarship programs at its discretion.
- **All scholarship applications will be acknowledged within 30 days.**
