## Fourth Year Free\* – See details at [pcci.edu/YearFree](http://pcci.edu/YearFree)

With a \$500 investment, students can attend their fourth year of college for free.

- The \$500 fee will need to be paid by June 15 (*fall applicants*) or December 1 (*spring applicants*).
- Standard tuition, room & board will be paid for 6 consecutive semesters. Free tuition, room and board\* will be received in the 7th and 8th semesters.

PCC maintains a part-time work assistance program for qualified residence hall students. Many of our students work on campus earning \$1,775–\$4,440 per year while gaining valuable skills.

- Students may apply to work 8–20 hrs. per week.
- International students may apply for other student employment.
- Work assistance is provided on the basis of financial need and work availability on campus.

A Beka Foundation Educational Fund provides low-interest loans of up to \$5,000 for qualified U.S. students.

### Scholarships

A *Beka* Foundation, Inc., provides scholarships for qualified students. Scholarships vary from \$700 to \$4,000.

### Fourth Year Free

This program allows qualified students to attend PCC and receive their fourth year free.

### Work Assistance

A great number of our students work on campus earning \$1,775–\$4,440 per year while gaining valuable skills.

### Loans

A *Beka* Foundation Educational Fund provides low-interest loans to qualified students.

A limited number of scholarships are available each year.

### Christian Service \$2,500–\$4,000

For students with parents serving full-time in a Bible-believing Christian ministry.

### Ministerial \$2,500–\$4,000

For students who have a declared a Bible major\* intending to be a minister of the gospel.

### Teacher Education \$2,500–\$4,000

For students who have declared an education major.

### Armed Services \$2,500–\$4,000

For students who were honorably discharged from the U.S. armed forces or have a parent who is currently serving or has previously served in the U.S. armed forces.\*

### Academic Honors \$2,000–\$3,200

For students who have a minimum GPA of 3.50 and were either valedictorian or salutatorian of their class or have scored a minimum composite score of 25 on the ACT or 1220 on the SAT.

### Alumni \$700–\$1,000

For students who have a parent who graduated from PCC in a four-year undergraduate program.

### A *Beka* Academy® Tuition Amount varies

For students who have completed at least a full 12th-grade enrollment through A *Beka* Academy, and have enrolled at PCC within one year of high school graduation. (May not be combined with Fourth-Year-Free program.)

### Applicant Qualifications

- Must declare a four-year major.
- Must be a U.S. or Canadian citizen, or U.S. permanent resident.
- Applicants may receive only one scholarship.
- Except where noted, applicants qualifying for scholarships may also apply for the Fourth-Year-Free program and/or work assistance for additional financial aid.
- Apply for scholarships by June 15 (fall applicants) or December 1 (spring applicants).
